



Escorting a Dog for the NWT SPCA

Thank you for volunteering your time and service to the NWT SPCA. We really depend on people like you to help relocate our wonderful northern specials either to an adopter down South or a trusted Animal Rescue organization. Here is how it will work. If you are travelling to a major city in Alberta or B.C like Edmonton, Calgary, Vancouver, Victoria, Kelowna, Nanimo, Comox or Abbotsford:

1. Please email or message us your information. For the potential flight we require your First and Last Name, cell number and your Six Letter locator code. This is the code that looks something like this - DQHTYS. We also require the date and times of your flight which include departure from Yellowknife and Arrival in the **final** destination city you are travelling to. Please include Flight numbers as well.
2. What we do with your information:
When we receive this information initially your name, code and date of flight, we contact our West Jet Friends to see if there is an available space on your flight. If there is they book a dog under your name at no charge. If there is room we will let you know you have a dog travelling with you.
3. We give you the information of the person picking up the dog on the other end and we give that person your information (name and cell). This is just in case there is a delay in flight or if there is a delay in pick up. This rarely happens.
4. The NWT SPCA staff will bring the dog to the Yellowknife airport, however you are required to meet us there for check in **90 minutes** prior to departure. This is a policy of West Jet. If we do not check in the dog at this time they can refuse the dog boarding the plane.
5. This is a very important program we are grateful to have. West Jet in Yellowknife is very generous to us and we do our best to show our gratitude and patience at check in. Thank you for your help. If you have any questions please contact Nicole at nwtspcayk@gmail.com.
